UPDATE FROM THE TRUSTEES

<u>Public Works & Water Committee</u> - 1.) Please continue to pay your water bill on time, or come in to set up a payment plan. Shutoff notices have been sent. If you have any problems with your water please visit the village hall and speak with the water department supervisor. Water department grant money has been issued to fix water hydrants. 2.) We are currently working on the removal of trees as the season is ending. Continue to contact the public works office for any tree removals.
