# AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING WATER SERVICE RATES FOR THE VILLAGE OF ROBBINS, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, the City of Chicago supplies water to the Village of Robbins; and

WHEREAS, on June 1, 2023 the Chicago Municipal Code states "beginning June 1, 2016, and every year thereafter, the annual rates shall be adjusted upwards, if applicable, by applying to the previous year's rate of inflation, calculated based on the Consumer Price Index- Urban Wage Earners and Clerical Workers (Chicago All Items) published by the United States Bureau of Labor Statistics for the 365-day period ending on the most recent January 1. Any such annual increase, however, shall be capped at 105% of the previous year's rate." The applicable Consumer Price Index inflation rate for 2022 was 5.16%.

WHEREAS, the budget contained increases in the water rates charged to suburban communities of 5% beginning June 1, 2023; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities have determined that in order to maintain the solvency of the Village's water system it is necessary to pass the rate increases on to the Village water consumers.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Board of Trustees of the Village of Robbins, Cook County, Illinois, in the exercise of Robbins' home rule powers as follows:

**SECTION 1:** The foregoing preambles are restated and incorporated herein by reference as though fully set forth herein.

**SECTION 2:** Effective August 1, 2023, the cost of water supplied to the Village's consumers shall be billed at the following monthly rates:

Water Min (first 2,000 Gallons): \$35.00

Water Rate Per 1,000 Gallons over 2,000 Gallons: \$11.00

Sewer Min (first 2,000 Gallons): \$5.75

Sewer Rate Per 1,000 Gallons over 2,000 Gallons: \$2.00

Garbage (Refuse): \$22.00

Service Fee: \$4.25

MISC Fee- (USDA): \$22.75

The Senior discount shall be applied by the Clerk, or the Clerk's designee, upon proof that the applicant owns the property in which they are seeking the Senior discount. The applicant must also present proof, as defined by the Clerk, that the applicant is over 65 years of age. Acceptable proof includes but is not limited to a valid state issued driver's license, state identification card, REAL identification or a passport.
