- I. Amendment of Ordinance No 8-26-03A, an Ordinance regulating liquor licenses in the Village of Robbins, IL
Sec 3-50 (e) change word 'shall' to 'may'
Sec 3-56 Class A-F, change to 10 each
Sec 3-57 increase to \$350
Sec 3-62 adding section (e): the local liquor control commissioner shall have the power to suspend any license if determined that the location has become out of compliance with any Illinois State liquor statute, ordinance or any other governing law. Once the location has become compliant with all Illinois liquor laws, the reactivation fee will be \$3500, paid in full for any class license. This amount can be amended at the end of each annual year
Sec 3-65 increase fees as such:
Categories A, C, D, F, will increase to \$5,000 per year
Categories B, E, will increase to \$3,000 per year
Add any application received after November 1, will be prorated to half the cost of the license fee.

- II. Amendment of Ordinance No 7-23-13B, an ordinance relating to licensing establishments with video gaming devices.
Sec 3-21 Increase terminal fees to \$500 for first gaming machine, \$250 each additional machine.

III. Discussion of Appropriations Budget Ordinance

Finance department has been working diligently to get the budget into the hands of the board for discussion. Focus this evening will be on the Police and Fire department. Police discussed administrative salaries, overtime, fuel, cameras, speed bumps and other traffic calming devices, uniforms. Dispatch service, not happy with current service from CalComm. Fire discussed training, fire safety. Working on three new job descriptions that will handle more of the administrative side of the department, yet still be operational (meaning they will still go out on calls). Spoke about the new ambulance coming and training needed, as well as the possible revenue to be generated. Discussed fuel, equipment needs current and future, vehicle maintenance. Station operational supplies needed, uniforms.
