Passport Information

For passport assistance, please contact our office for an appointment.

To apply, you must have...

- A completed DS-11 application (available at our office)
- Proof of US Citizenship
- One passport picture (2" x 2")
- Proof of identity
- Social security number

Fees:

PASSPORT BOOK (air, land and sea travel)

- \$165 - 10-year passport book (16 years and older)
- \$135 - 5-year passport book (under 16 years old)
- \$60 - expedite fee - optional

PASSPORT CARD (land and sea travel)

- \$65 - 10-year passport card (16 years and older)
- \$50 - 5-year passport card (under 16 years old)
- \$60 - expedite fee - optional

Average processing time: 4-6 weeks; or 2-3 weeks expedited. Times slightly longer during the pandemic.

Payments may be made by check or money order. **Two checks** are required for each transaction. Details are available in the Clerk's Office.

The Clerk's Office also maintains a supply of travel brochures. Stop by to pick up free copies.



Voter Registration Services

The Clerk's Office provides many services to residents and visitors of Worth Township including: voter registration, temporary handicap parking permits, notary public services, passport acceptance and US travel brochures.



Temporary Handicap Placards

If you qualify to receive a temporary handicap placards and your physician is available to sign off on your application, the Clerk's Office staff is able to help process that application through the Illinois Secretary of State Office.

Stop by our Clerk's Office and they will assist with the completion of the form that will have to be signed by your physician.

Notary Public

If you are looking to have an official document notarized, the staff of our Clerk's Office can help. Just bring in that document, unsigned, with a form of identification issued by a government, and our staff can notarize.

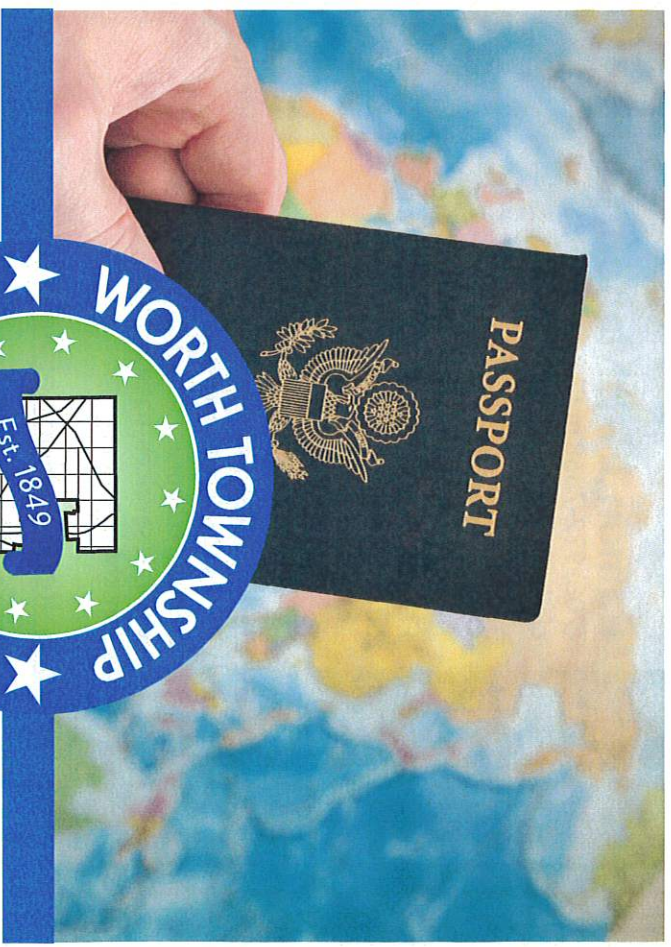

Clerk's Office

Need a little financial help?

Worth Township offers General Assistance, a short-term locally administered welfare program for persons who do not qualify for any other state or federal assistance. Those eligible have either very low or no income or financial resources. Residents must be 18 years of age or older, with no minor children, and must meet all eligibility requirements.



Food Pantry

Visitors to the Township's Food Pantry has been significantly higher in the past year or so due to the pandemic. To meet those needs, the Township has expanded services. The donation of a walk-in cooler has also enabled visitors to now receive dairy products and other perishable foods. For everyone's safety during the pandemic, patrons are asked to pick up food near the rear entrance of the building.

The Township has partnered with the Greater Chicago Food Depository and is able to offer a selected menu of food to choose from along with two prepackaged bags. Foods range from at least one meat selection as well as fresh fruits and vegetables when available.

Pantry patrons must be residents of Worth Township and can visit the pantry twice a month. If you are not a resident of Worth Township, you are allowed to use the Township Food Pantry once. Patrons need to bring in a current picture ID with their name and current address.

Food Pantry Hours of Operation:
Monday – Thursday, 9:00 am – 2:00 pm.



Emergency Assistance

Emergency Assistance is a one-time financial grant, in a 12-month period, available to any Worth Township resident facing a life-threatening circumstance such as eviction or utility disconnection. Emergency Assistance funds go directly to the utility, landlord or bank.



Fire Assistance

Fire Assistance is available for Township residents who have experienced hardship due to a fire. A fire report from the responding fire department is mandatory for assistance

General Assistance

**Worth Township ~ PACE
Senior Transportation Pilot Program**

Transportation Services:

Worth Township provides curb-to-curb service to seniors ages 55 and older, and adults with disabilities ages 18+ that live within the boundaries of Worth Township. You must be registered to ride the bus. Passengers who are unable to get to and from the bus will require an escort. All caregivers must also be registered.

Transportation is available for medical appointments and grocery shopping.

This service operates Monday through Thursday from 8:00 am – 3:00 pm. Last pickup is at 2:30 pm. We provide service on a first come, first serve basis and reservations should be made 24 hours in advance by calling (708) 972-7075.

Township Boundaries:

87th Street – 135th Street
Western – Harlem
(excludes Chicago)

In addition to the Worth Township area, we also provide transportation to Hi-Tech, Palos Hospital, and medical offices on College Dr.

Cost

\$3 each way (exact fare required)
\$6 round trip (exact fare required)
\$25 10-ride pass (\$5 savings)

Cancellations:

Passengers must personally notify the dispatcher of any cancellations as soon as possible. Multiple failures to advise of cancellation will result in a suspension of riding privileges.

Reserve your ride by calling (708) 972-7075 between 8:00 am and noon on the day before you wish to ride the bus.

When given an appointment time, please understand that the driver may arrive up to 15 minutes earlier or later than your scheduled time. It is nearly impossible to schedule with complete accuracy. The nature of our ridership requires patience and flexibility. In addition, we are always at the mercy of the weather. We appreciate your cooperation with scheduling and request you be ready 15 minutes in advance of your scheduled time.

Services for our Residents

- Certificate of Error Application
- Assessed Valuation Appeals are filings with the Cook County Assessor and the Cook County Board of Review
- Sidwell Maps maintained and assistance in locating property, verifying Permanent Index Numbers, and providing legal descriptions
- Researching Permanent Index Numbers, recent residential sale prices, local tax rates/estimates and comparable property values.
