- I. Presentation given by Mr. Marcus Chapman of Hub International explaining the status of the village's insurance coverage. He stated that because of multiple claims in the past, current possible and/or pending lawsuits and the financial status of the community, he only could find one company willing to insure the village (he had reached out to 52 companies) and it was not sufficient coverage. He explained what was covered and what was left uncovered. Explained the village's coverage expired at midnight and that the board needed to make a decision today to bind some type of insurance.  
Discussion and questions between Mr. Chapman and the board as to how we got to this place, what can be done to get additional coverage, how soon will the village be covered if they approve binding today, cost of financing, etc. Can't discuss financing until we determine what we're binding.  
It was moved by Trustee Robinson and seconded by Trustees Maxey and Jackson for approval of Insurance Premiums.

Mr. Ward-Could HR explain the general liability, what does it actually cover.  
Ms. Shelton-What were the issues as to why it was so challenging to find a carrier? Stated the things the village is doing to provide information.  
Ms. Ratliff-How much is the premium and where does the money come from?  
Ms. Echols-We got here because of what happened in the past. This board is faced with past mismanagement, we have to stand together.

Andrea Roberson-Is the community center going to be closed until we have a meeting? The park district has coverage on the building. Concerned about the events going on there now.

Mr. Ward-Biggest problem is changing the narrative of the village.

Ms. Murphy-Are we putting training in place for public works/police?

Ms. Williams-I appreciate you acknowledging your mistakes.

Ms. Murphy-Are we looking to have another company cover the buildings that don't have coverage?

Ms. Williams-Nervous about using the elevator in the building, been jerking.

Final recap with Mr. Chapman as to the next step.
